The Southern Centre has started the process of working with designers and applying for funding to re-develop a key area within the centre. Key designers, Absolutely Integrated have developed a Movement Sensor System, a piece of equipment that detects movements by participants and translates it into music.

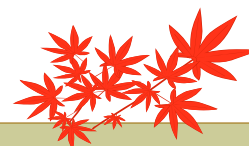
This piece will enhance participants experiences in the centre and enable people to 'play' music independently. This is an extremely innovative piece being designed specifically for the Southern Centre.
